# 9 Certain Predictions That Can Give Believers Peace

*"We have also a more sure word of prophecy"* (2Pet. 1:19)

Have you ever considered the value of advanced information? If the world knew on 9/10 about 9/11, do you think things would have been different? The Bible says concerning its prophecy: *"whereunto ye do well to take heed...until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts"*. Treasure and meditate on the following prophecies.

#### The World won't end by climate change caused by man's pollution

The Creator promises that as long as this present earth remains, "cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease", Gen. 8:22. 'Mother earth' does not need saved. She is not our life-giver. The Father is its creator and sustainer by His Son.

#### The World will end by climate change – caused by the pollution of sin

Mankind won't repent of its sin: idolatry, illicit sexual unions, murders, stealing and spirit guidance. Therefore, on God's judgment day, the sun will be effected by God's angel and man will be "*scorched with great heat*". There will be thunder as the world's greatest earthquake hits accompanied with huge ice rocks falling from the sky, Rev. 9:20-21 / chap. 16. Man drinking a bottle of purified water or not killing a whale will *not* mask his polluted heart and sins before God. It is man that needs saved. And Jesus saves!

#### Irrational Thinking and godless behavior will rise in societies

As a society rejects the revelation of God in creation they regress into the darkness of human rationale. This becomes evident in a progression of perverted life styles for their minds are now blinded. So, incapable of judging wisely anymore, they cannot recognize it as perversion. With "*a reprobate mind*" they will sincerely "*call evil good, and good evil*". This results in societal disasters from dysfunctional families to deceiving politics accompanied by all kinds of diseases, death, divorce, depression and hateful rebellion – but still claiming to know God in religion: hypocrisy! Romans 1/2Tim. 3:1-5 / Isa.5:20.

#### The "Church" will grow increasingly corrupt

The prophesied legalizing of the gospel has, is and will continue to happen; such as the infiltration of demonic teaching that forbids marrying, and disallowing the eating of meat at times. The gospel also will be liberalized where grace is perverted and justifies the practice of sin without judging. Also *"the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine"* with the increase of teachers that turn from the truth to satisfy the people's desire to have their ego and self-esteem fulfilled. 1Tim. 4:1-5 / Jude :4 / 2Tim. 4:3-4.

#### The Nations will further turn Anti-Semitic

Expect more governments to be against Israel's existence in their land and their claim to the capital city of Jerusalem. The Lord has prophesied, "*I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken*". Jerusalem is the one earthly city God has chosen on which to attach His eternal Name. To destroy Jerusalem and the Jews by another god is to defeat God Himself. It's a satanic thing, you see. Zech 14:2 / 1Kings 11:36.

## The Mideast's (Israel) darkest hour is still ahead of her

Israel has a dilemma. She claims a covenant relationship with God as His chosen servants on earth but has rejected and crucified God's only Son, Messiah Jesus. Her main issue is not land or foreigners but God. To break her of her Christ-less confidence (unbelief), God will bring her into "great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world". All nations will hate her, betray her, rape her, scatter her, and hunt her until she is at the brink of annihilation with no human help. Matt. 24:21 / Jer. 30:7 / Daniel 12:1.

## The Mideast's (Israel) greatest hour is still ahead of her

All Israel shall be politically and spiritually saved after she is broken and repents. This is caused by her coming time of great trouble from the Lord. Then there will be disarmament of the militaries and *"Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited"*. All nations will also then be blessed. This will happen not by man's politics but by the coming again of Israel's true Messiah, the Lord Jesus Christ. Zech. 13, 14 / Isa. 2:1-4 / Rom. 11:25-28.

#### The Church will leave this world before destruction comes

By their faith, believers overcome the world through Jesus Christ and are the true church (called out ones from the world's sin and judgment), 1Jn. 5:4-5 / Gal. 1:4. Because the Lord Jesus bore their judgment on the cross they are not appointed to experience the wrath of God coming on this world. The Lord has promised, "*I will come again*". First He comes to the air for the church, and then He will come back to Israel with the glorified church to judge and then rule the world. 1Thess. 5:9-10 / John 14:3 / Rev. 17:14 / Zech. 14:3-4.

## Every Person will personally meet God

All roads do lead to God. But where do you go after that? All unsaved will stand before God to give an account before being consigned to the eternal lake of fire. Each saved person with bended knee will *"give an account of himself to God"* before receiving service rewards and return with their Lord. Rev.20:11-15 / Rom. 14:11-12 / 1Cor. 3:13-15.

Trusting these prophecies gives one a sure and positive hope for the future. In simple language, *we win* in Christ. Sin will eventually be put down and righteousness exalted. Justice and equity will rule and there will be peace on earth. Knowing this can produce tremendous practical benefits now. It will affect thinking from making the right choices with your time and service for the Lord to peace in your heart in troubled times.

For example, if you're watching a ballgame and your team is losing, you would be very anxious until they came from behind and won. But if you already knew the final winning score and were viewing the game on video replay, now when your team is doing poorly you are quite calm. The difference is knowing the end in advance. Then changes now.
