His Life on Earth:

That follower also committed suicide – *not a successful counselor or psychologist*
He called religious hypocrites snakes and tombs – *not successful in sensitivity training*
He spoke on negative subjects like sin and hell – *not a successful positive thinker*
He believed in creation as he read it in Genesis – *not a successful scientist*
He believed in male and female
He believed in marriage between a man and a woman
He was against the consensus on divorce and remarriage – *not a successful populist*
He was hated by the religious establishment – *not successful in cultural adaptation*
