What are God's Interests for the new relationship? – the way explained

- 54. 1 Timothy – Warfare** ***“war a good warfare”*** 1:18
- Warning of false teachers – *“Teachers of the law, understanding neither what they say”* 1:9
- Worship in holiness – *“that men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands”* 2:8
- Women's role – *“I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to learn in silence. For Adam was first formed, then Eve”* 2:12-13
- Workers qualifications – *“a good work...a bishop [overseer] must...let the deacons be...”* 8:34
- Warning of false teaching – *“forbidding to marry...commanding to abstain from meats”* 4:3
- Wisdom for life – *“Give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine”* 4:13
- Widows Care – *“Honor widows that are widows indeed... well reported of for good...”* 5:3,10
- Wealth's traps – *“They that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare...hurtful lusts”* 6:9
- Wonders of Lord – *“Lord of lords; Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light”* 1:17
“Unto the King, eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God be honor and glory” 6:15-16
- 55. 2 Timothy – Truth** ***“the word of truth”*** 2:15
- Truth retained – *“Hold fast the form of sound words...in faith and love...in Christ Jesus”* 1:13
- Truth repeated – *“the things...heard of me...the same commit thou to faithful men...”* 2:2
- Truth reached – *“Study...unto God, a workman...rightly dividing the word of truth”* 2:15
- Truth reshaped – *“Who concerning the truth have erred...and overthrow the faith of some”* 2:18
- Truth recovered – *“Repentance to the acknowledging of the truth...they may recover”* 2:25-26
- Truth resisted – *“never able to come to the knowledge of the truth...also resist the truth”* 3:7,8
- Truth recorded – *“The holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation”* 3:15
- Truth required – *“All scripture...is profitable...That the man of God may be perfect”* 3:16-17
- Truth reminded – *“Preach the word...rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine”* 4:2
- Truth relinquished – *“Will not endure...doctrine...turn away their ears from the truth”* 4:3-4
- 56. Titus – Good (godly)** ***“Teachers of good things...live...godly”*** 2:3, 12
- Pastoring good – *“Elders...must be...a lover of hospitality, a lover of good...”* 1:5-8
- Paternal good – *“...Women...to love their husbands...children...keepers at home, good”* 2:4-5
- Pattern of good – *“In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine...”* 2:7
- Portraying good – *“Servants to be obedient...shewing all good...may adorn the doctrine”* 2:9-10
- Passionate for good – *“[Christ] might redeem us...unto himself...zealous of good works”* 2:14
- Politically good – *“Obey magistrates...ready to every good work...speak evil of no man”* 3:1-2
- Perpetuating good – *“Be careful to maintain good works. These things are good...”* 3:8
- 57. Philemon – Love and Faith** ***“love and faith...toward the Lord Jesus”*** 1:5
- Onesimus, a runaway servant gets saved and now Philemon is asked to receive him back - as a brother*
- Reckless Past – *“Which in time past was to thee unprofitable...departed...for a season”* :11,15
- Receive Personally – *“I have sent again...thou...receive him...is, mine own bowels [heart]”* :12
- Receive Perpetually – *“Departed for a season, that thou shouldest receive him forever”* :15

Receive in family Privilege – “**Receive** him...not...as a servant, but...a brother beloved” :15,16

Receive on merits of Partner – “Thou count me...a partner, **receive** him as myself” :17

Re-Payment / by another – “He...oweth thee...put that on mine account...I will **repay**” :18,19
