| As 4 gospels give 4 aspects of one life, death and resurrection of Christ so the hereafter follows this way Each account starts with something being opened to do with the 7 sealed book Something connected with the Old Testament tabernacle is then seen Each then gives new details of the 7 seal's judgments, but each starts at a different point in the 7 years Each takes you to the same the day of God's wrath being fully poured out – but with new details. And each ends with the same coming kingdom victory for God's saints – but with new details |
